SB 1888 – Texas First Early High School Completion

SB 1888 amended TEC §28.0253, by removing "pilot" from the Texas First Early High School Completion Program. This program allows public high school students who demonstrate early readiness for college to graduate early from high school. A student who earns a high school diploma through this program is considered to have earned a distinguished level of achievement under the foundation high school program.

Initially, TEA added one new data element, TEXAS-FIRST-EARLY-HIGH-SCHOOL-COMPLETION-PROGRAM (E1736) and a corresponding code table. In TEDS version 2024.2.1, TEA added one new GRADUATION-TYPE-CODE (E0806/C062).



Students who graduate early under this program automatically receive distinguished level of achievement for graduation and the students do not have endorsements. These students are not FHSP graduates - TEA is working with cleaning up the language for the 2024-2025 school year.

HB 2729 – ECDS High-Quality Pre-Kindergarten

HB 2729 amends TEC §29.167(b), which changes the additional requirements for each teacher of record for a pre-kindergarten program class serving eligible four-year-old students.

TEA removed two codes and added seven new codes to the PK-TEACHER-REQUIREMENT (C207) table.

SB 763 – PEIMS New Role-ID

SB 763 adds TEC §23.001, School Chaplains, which allows a public school to employ or accept as volunteers chaplains. A chaplain employed under this subsection is not required to be certified by the State Board for Educator Certification.

TEA added one new ROLE-ID (C021) to allow an LEA to report a School Chaplain.

HB 114 – PEIMS Discipline

HB 114 amends TEC §37.006 to direct a mandatory disciplinary alternative education program (DAEP) placement for a student observed possessing, using, being under the influence, selling, giving, or delivering to another person marihuana or tetrahydrocannabinol on or within 300 feet of school property or while attending a school-sponsored or school-related activity on or off of school property. Additionally, the bill directs a mandatory DAEP placement for a student observed possessing, using, selling, giving, or delivering to another person an e-cigarette.

TEA added three new codes to the DISCIPLINARY-ACTION-REASON-CODE (C165) table, revised one existing code, updated and added rules.



If the incident is also a discretionary expulsion reason, then the disciplinary action may be an expulsion. 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HB 114 – PEIMS Discipline

HB 114 also amends TEC §37.009 to add a procedure for student placement in a DAEP when the DAEP is at capacity, or a position is needed for a student who engaged in violent conduct.

TEA added a new code to the DISCIPLINARY-LENGTH-DIFFERENCE-REASON-CODE (C166) table and added two new rules.

HB 8 – PEIMS Associate Degree Indicator

HB 8 amends TEC §29.908(b). A participating student can complete high school and enroll in a program at an institution of higher education that will enable the student to, on or before the fifth anniversary of the date of the student's first day of high school, receive a high school diploma and either: (A) an applied associate degree, or (B) an academic associate degree.

TEA added a new code table, updated data element reporting requirements, and updated and added a rule.

Beginning in PEIMS 2023-2024 Summer Submission, the associate indicator C235 table will drill down even further and LEAs will need to indicate type of associate degree earned.





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HB 8 – Revised Data Element Reporting Requirements

StudentExtension

DR47

ASSOCIATE-DEGREE-INDICATOR-CODE (E1596) indicates that the student earned an associate degree by August 31, immediately following graduation.

An associate degree is defined as an award that normally requires at least 2 but less than 4 years of full-time equivalent college work in a grouping of courses designed to lead the individual directly to employment in a specific career or to transfer to an upper-level baccalaureate program. This specifically refers to the associate of arts, associate of science, associate of applied arts, associate of applied science, associate of arts in teaching, and associate of occupational studies degrees. The term "applied" in an associate degree name indicates a program in which the content is primarily technical. (Source: Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board Glossary of Terms)

For the 2023-2024 PEIMS Fall Submission (1):

Local education agencies (LEAs) should report the associate degree earned by a graduate (if not previously reported) from the 2022-2023 school year using the PARTICIPATION-INDICATOR-CODE (C088) table.

For the 2023-2024 PEIMS Summer Submission (3):

LEAs should report the associate degree earned at any point in the 2023-2024 school year by a student in 11th or 12th grade using the ASSOCIATE-DEGREE-INDICATOR (C235) table.

For the 2024-2025 PEIMS Fall Submissions and after:

The district where the student received the associate degree will be the district to report this information using the ASSOCIATE-DEGREE-INDICATOR (C235) table. Schools should not wait to report the associate degree information at the point of graduation if the student earns the associate degree prior to graduation. It should be reported in the next PEIMS Submission after the degree is earned.

A student may be reported as having earned an associate degree at any point while in 11th or 12th grade or by August 31 immediately following graduation.

HB 3708 – PEIMS Non-Enrolled UIL Participant

HB 3708 adds TEC §48.305, which provides an annual allotment to a school district of \$1,500 per University Interscholastic League (UIL) activity in which non-enrolled students participate. A non-enrolled student is a homeschooled student who predominantly receives instruction in a general elementary or secondary education program provided by the parent or person standing in parental authority in or through the child's home.

TEA added a new data element, code table, revised reporting requirements, and updated and added rules in the PEIMS Summer Submission.

** Program area is working on specific rules that constitutes participation - TEA PEIMS team wanted to make LEAs aware because this will be reported in PEIMS Summer Submission.



HB 3708 – More Information

- Each LEA determines if non-enrolled homeschool participation is allowed.
 Based on local policy
- The allotment would not apply to students enrolled in full-time TXVSN school options because TXVSN schools are public schools.
- LEAs will need to assign a Unique ID to non-enrolled (homeschooled) students to report the student in the PEIMS Summer Submission.

If an LEA determines that non-enrolled homeschool participation is allowed, the LEA needs to discuss with their vendor how to enter in the non-enrolled students in their software since the students are only being reported in the PEIMS Summer submission



Question: What about a homeschool student in an online virtual program? Answer: This will depend on what type of online virtual program the student is in. If it is through a public school, the student is not eligible for this allotment. If it is an online virtual school homeschool program that is not through a public school, then the student is eligible.



HB 3708 – More Information

- Non-enrolled (homeschooled) students may only participate in UIL school activities in the school district that a student would be eligible to attend based on the student's residential address.
- Non-enrolled (homeschooled) students must meet certain grading requirements (TEC §33.0832(f-h)) to participate in UIL Activities.
- Non-enrolled (homeschooled) students are not authorized to participate in a league activity during the remainder of any school year during which the student was previously enrolled in a public school. (TEC §33.0832(i))

HB 3803 – PEIMS Parent Request Retention

HB 3803 amends TEC §28.02124 to allow a parent or guardian to request a student repeat any course for high school credit in which the student was enrolled during the previous school year and to repeat grades prekindergarten through eight.

TEC §28.02124 was initially added by SB 1697 from the 87th Legislative Session.

TEA revised the special instructions for the PARENT-REQUEST-RETENTION-INDICATOR (E1729) data element and updated one data validation rule.

HB 3803 – More Information

- A local school district or open-enrollment charter school policy will determine if a parent can request a student repeat a high school credit course for a higher grade. (See TEC §§28.02124(a-1) and 28.02124(g))
- If a parent requests a student repeat a course for high school credit under TEC §28.02124, the time that the student spends taking the course for a subsequent time **does** count towards the accumulation of attendance hours for FSP funding purposes. The course does count in the 2 through 4 hour rule for FSP funding the time spent in the course does count. The SAAH will be reflected in October to reflect this.
- A student repeating one high school credit course is not at-risk. Students in grades
 1-8 would be coded at-risk if not advanced from one grade to the next at the request of a parent.



 A parent can enroll a five-year-old student in prekindergarten if the student would have been eligible to enroll in prekindergarten during the previous school year under TEC §29.153(b) and the student has not yet enrolled in kindergarten.



HB 1416 – TREx Accelerated Instruction

HB 1416 amends TEC §28.0211 related to accelerated and supplemental instruction for students. Each student that fails to achieve at least satisfactory performance on each assessment instrument administered under TEC §39.023 must be provided supplemental instruction for no less than 15 hours or 30 hours for a student whose performance on the applicable assessment instrument was significantly below satisfactory, as defined by commissioner rule.

TEA added five new data elements and two new code tables to the Texas Records Exchange (TREx) to allow an LEA to transfer information about the accelerated learning plan developed and completed for a student.

HB 3 – TREx Discipline

HB 3 amends TEC §25.002(a) to include in the documents required to be transferred when a student moves from one school to a new school a copy of the child's disciplinary record and any threat assessment involving the child's behavior under §37.115.

TEA is developing a method in TREx to automatically transfer prior year discipline records using the PEIMS Summer discipline records. LEAs will also need to send threat assessment information and current year discipline records from one LEA to a new LEA at the time of a student's transfer. TEA has added 11 new, revised three existing and deleted one data element. TEA has also added two new code tables.



TREx currently only sends the open discipline records - this change includes historical records. Historical in PEIMS is 5 years (Texas Archive Commission)



HB 4375 – TREx Automated External Defibrillator Instruction

HB 4375 amends TEC §28.0023 to add instruction in the use of an automated external defibrillator (AED) to the existing required instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation techniques for students in grades seven through twelve.

AED training will be added to the existing CPR training. TEA will add this requirement to the existing CPR-INSTRUCTION-MET-DATE (TE122) in TREx. Pending rule development.





88th Legislative Regular Session



HB 1416 – PEIMS Accelerated Instruction

HB 1416 amends TEC §28.0211 related to accelerated and supplemental instruction for students. Each student that fails to achieve at least satisfactory performance on each assessment instrument administered under TEC §39.023 must be provided supplemental instruction for no less than 15 hours or 30 hours for a student whose performance on the applicable assessment instrument was significantly below satisfactory, as defined by commissioner rule. The agency shall monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of the accelerated instruction required under this section.

TEA has published an <u>early notice</u> on September 1, 2023, with the information on collecting new data elements in the 2024-2025 PEIMS Summer Submission.







HB 2209 – PEIMS Rural Pathway Excellence Partnership

HB 2209 adds the Rural Pathway Excellence Partnership (R-PEP), which allows rural school districts to enter into agreements with other school districts to develop rural college and career pathway partnerships. The funding for the program comes from the Foundation School Program and provides for outcomes bonuses based on a student from the program obtaining not later than five years after high school graduation a postsecondary credential of value.

TEA is working to determine what will be needed to implement this bill during the 2024-2025 school year.







SB 1647 – PEIMS Dropout Recovery Education Programs

SB 1647 amends TEC §29.081 to allow an LEA to operate a dropout recovery program using an education management organization in addition to methods that are currently used. The bill outlines the requirements for teachers and how the program is offered (remote, hybrid, in-person). The bill also outlines new requirements for these dropout recovery programs, which would provide an attendance rate for students who successfully complete a course offered through the program.

TEA is working to determine what will be needed to implement this bill during the 2024-2025 school year.
