> If the Summer PEIMS data is not loading into OnDataSuite, you will not see any current year data on reports.

> > When running or creating reports in OnDataSuite, ALWAYS check to make sure the report data is for 2024-2025.

Ad-Hoc Reporting in ODS

What is an Ad-Hoc Report?

An Ad-Hoc Report is generally created for a specific request or reason.

Ad hoc is a Latin term which translates as "to this." However, it's also understood as "as needed" or "as required."



Creating Ad-Hoc Reports

- Select the initial "Category", to begin.
 - Use the "Data Source Information" for information on each category
 - Select desired year(s), or leave blank to display all years
- Select "Criteria",
 - Includes a list of elements pertaining to the category selected
 - Filter options available if needed
- "Create Report" green box on far top right corner under Report Commands
